Mendoza





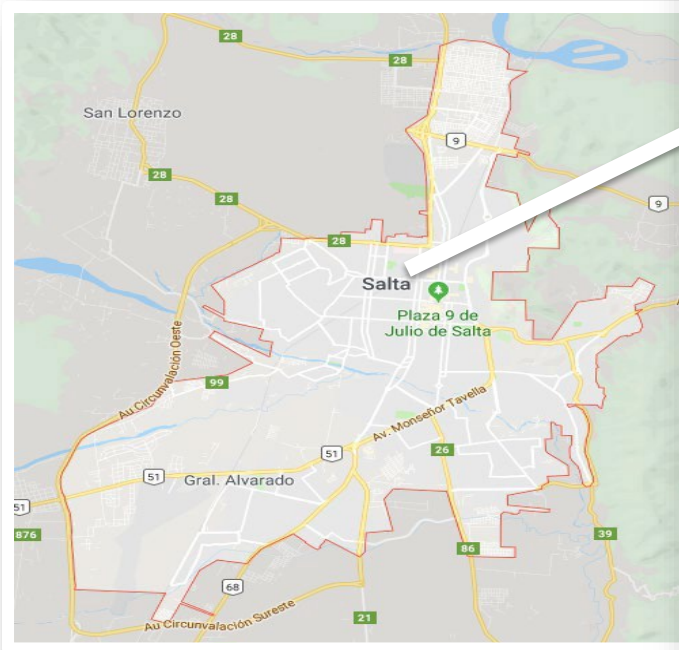
Mendoza Pros

Salta





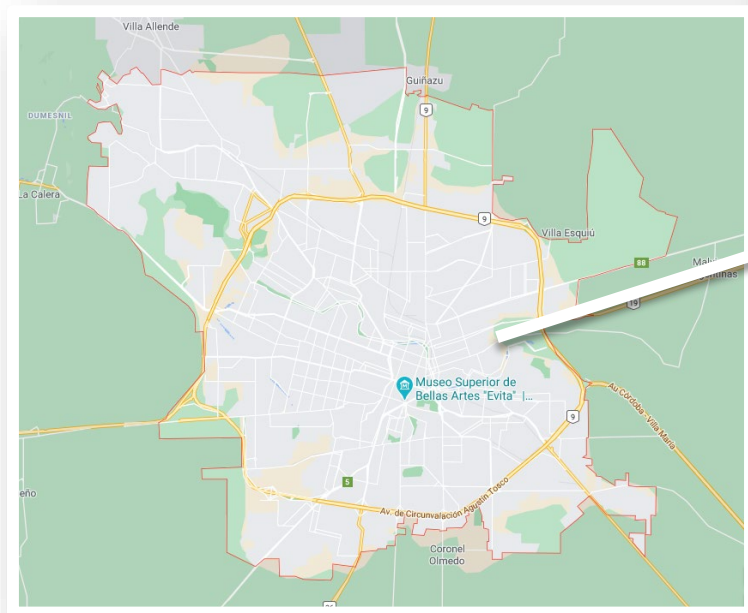
Salta Pros

Córdoba





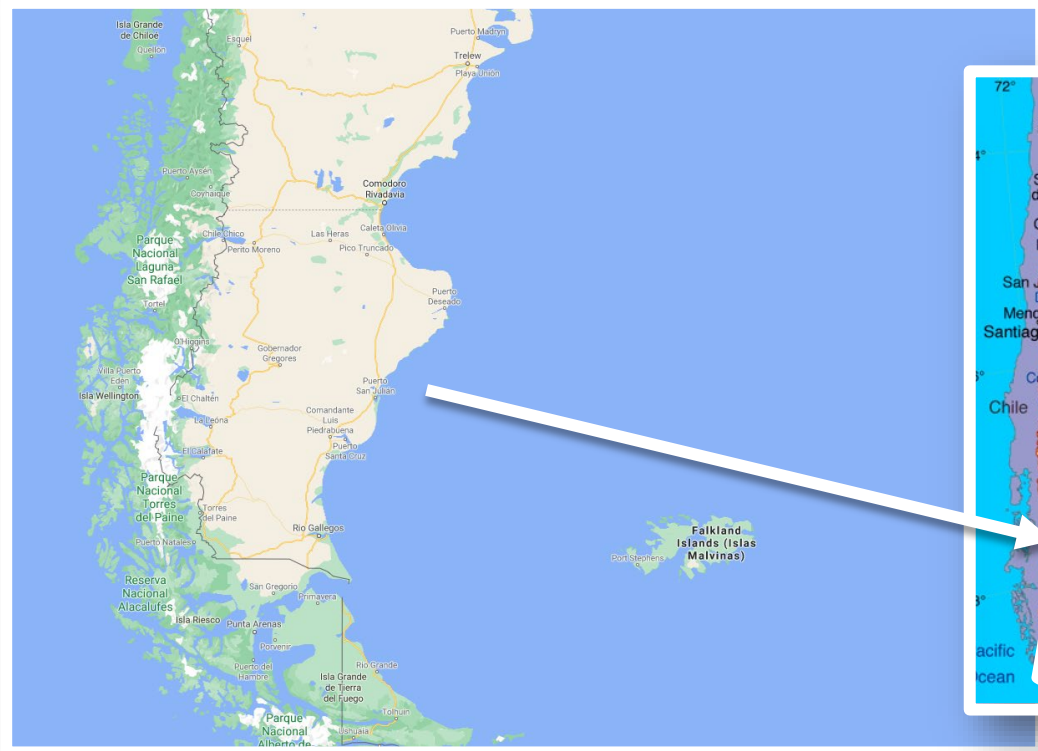
Córdoba Pros

- Longer flights; 1000 miles from Bs As

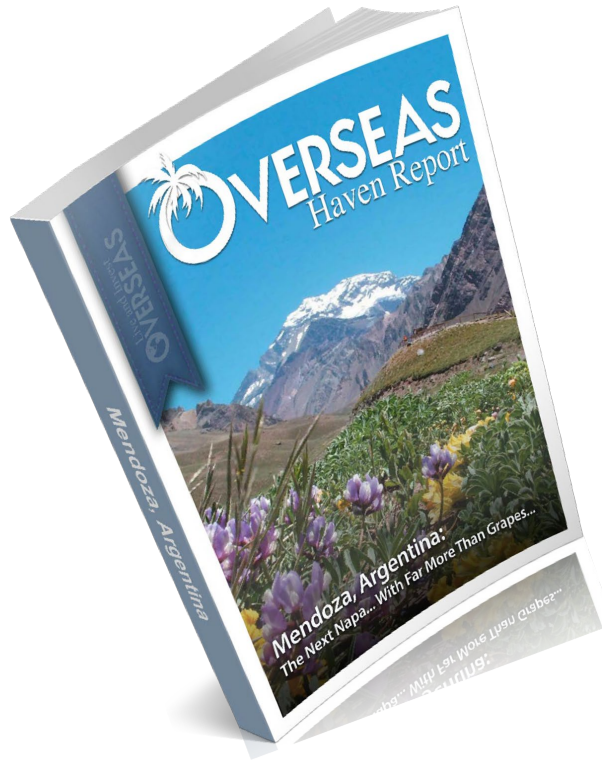
Noteworthy
